Vocational education and training (VET) provides valid and important pathway options for many students. External VET partners with industry and government to provide people with workplace skills and technical knowledge to help them advance their career now and in the future. Students can access VET programs through an external Registered Training Organisation (RTO). These courses can be funded by VET in Schools Funding (VETiS). This funding is managed by the school and the associated costs are identified in the relevant section of this guide.
